



LAKE TOMBIGBEE CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

You are aware that you are entering the Reservation lands of the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas, a federally recognized Indian Tribe. As such, you are voluntarily subjecting yourself to the laws of the Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas. Lake Tombigbee Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone not complying with these rules and regulations. The Alabama-Coushatta Tribe of Texas and the Lake Tombigbee Staff are not responsible for any lost articles, damage to your vehicle, or personal injury. Please read carefully, and treat your neighbors with respect.

1. Check in time is 12pm (3pm Cabins). Please notify the Lake Office if you are checking in after 5 PM. Check out time is 12PM. If you plan to arrive earlier or stay later, you will need to pay a fee prior to extending your time.
2. All vehicles must have a pass displayed to enter the Campground. Passes are good for the duration of your stay. You are limited to 2 vehicles per campsite. Additional parking can be purchased from the Lake Office.
3. Gas/propane generators are not allowed anywhere on the Campground.
4. Tents are not allowed on cabin sites - additional tent sites must be purchased.
5. "Pack-In, Pack-Out" your trash. Please tend to your own trash and drop trash bags into the large blue bins. Please do not burn trash in fire rings or grills. We appreciate your cooperation in keeping your area clean.
6. Pets are allowed to stay in kennels or carriers, and must be kept on a leash when walked (away from common areas – pavilion, playground, swim area and bathhouses). Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their pets, financially responsible for any damages, and may be removed if pets are loud or disturb other campers.
7. Speed limit: 20 mph. Please drive carefully and watch for children and pedestrians.
8. Quiet time: 10PM to 8AM. Excessively loud music, noises, and bright lights will not be tolerated during this time.
9. Campers are responsible for actions or misconduct caused by their children or guests.
10. Fishing hours are from dawn to dusk. A fishing license is not required. Overnight fishing and fishing from rental paddleboats, kayaks or canoes is not permitted. Nightcrawlers and supplies are sold at the Lake Office.
11. Public consumption of alcohol is not allowed. Alcohol use must be restricted to your assigned site, and glass containers kept inside tents, cabins and RV's. Tribal Law Enforcement will remove violators immediately.
12. Firewood is available for sale at the Lake Office in ten piece stacks. No cutting of trees or shrubbery allowed, however you are welcome to gather wood on the ground. Violators will be removed from the park.
13. Changing campsites must be approved by the office prior to moving. Any changes or requests are at the discretion of Lake Management.
14. Firearms, the discharging of fireworks, and illegal substances are strictly prohibited. Violators will be removed and subject to arrest.
15. Campfires must be contained within your site and extinguished before retiring or leaving the area. No fires allowed during county-wide burn bans.
16. Motorized watercraft (trolling motors are allowed), ATVs, golf carts, and the like are prohibited.
17. Anyone vandalizing the Tribal Campground or Tribal lands will be prosecuted.

Refund Policy

1. Refund requests are subject to a \$10 service fee, and must be processed using the credit card number used with the original charge. Credit issued instead is not subject to the service fee.
2. Cancelling your reservation within 48 hours of your scheduled check-in time will result in a credit issued for the full amount paid, which must be used by the end of the calendar year from time of purchase, with a minimum redemption period of one month.
3. We are not responsible for negative experiences from other guests, and a refund will not be granted due to their actions, however we will not tolerate aggressive or lewd behavior, and Tribal Police will be notified to eject the responsible party from the Campgrounds.
4. If you or any member of your party is removed from the park, you will not be refunded the balance of your stay.
5. No refunds will be issued for early departure or during inclement weather. You are allowed one reschedule request to be used before the end of the calendar year per reservation.
